- Each candidate for the position of Elder must be affirmed in his selection by no less than 85% of the members present at a duly-convened general meeting of the Church."

- We invite you to consult the Scriptures and pray about and for those nominated. We also invite you to approach the candidates directly with any questions, thoughts or encouragement you might have regarding their nomination.
- Candidates can withdraw from consideration at any time in the process should they choose to do so. The affirmation vote will take place at the *Wednesday, November 27, Congregational Bi-Annual General Meeting.*
