Ingredients necessary for personal devotions

- 1. A good Bible for reading and memorization
- 2. A paper or digital notebook to write things down or say them out loud.
- 3. A personal prayer list.
- 4. A quiet place somewhere.
- 5. A specific time during the day.
- 6. An expectant spirit Ask, "Is my heart open to tell Jesus all that is on my heart? Is my heart open to hear what Jesus wants to say? Am I only trying to rush through this?

Suggested Format for Personal Devotions.

- Pray, sharing your heart with God and your expectancy to meet with Him.
- Read/listen to a passage of Scripture. Start with Gospel of Matthew; Mark, Luke or John.
- Write down or note one thing from the passage that spoke to you.
- Respond in prayer to what stood out to you.
- Confess sin; thank Him for forgiveness; bring prayer items before God.
