The Mission Committee's purpose is to serve, and support others who are serving, locally, nationally and internationally. Currently, we support missionaries with SEND, NABC, OM, Salaam Ministries, Faith at Home and Ethnos. We support international ministries with Chain of Love (Brazil), Compassion (Honduras), HART (Ukraine), Project Jesus For Children (Central America), Operation Christmas Child, White Cross (Cameroon & Nigeria) and International Justice Mission. More locally, we support the Pregnancy Care Centre, St. Albert Food Bank, Kaleo, Kinettes Hampers, Kettle Campaign, The Bridge, Coats for Kids & Every Home for Christ.

Throughout the year, there are many ways you can get involved with our missionaries and ministries. We strive to keep you updated on prayer requests and ways you can help.




